Complete application packets must be submitted by 5:00 PM on Friday, February 21, 2020.

The application packet must include the following:

1. Application Form (*see next page*)

- a. Two references are requested on this form. One must be a former employer or faculty member at your college.

2. Curriculum Vitae (CV)

- a. Include all:
 - i. Positions held during undergraduate and veterinary education
 - ii. Publications, honors/awards, society and committee memberships, etc.

3. Personal Essay/Letter of intent

- a. This is limited to one page, single-spaced and must characterize your:
 - i. Interest in laboratory animal medicine
 - ii. Career goals
 - iii. Any general or specific research interests

Optional: One letter of reference from a former employer or faculty member at your college. This letter should be independently submitted (i.e., directly by the reference) to the contact below and is held to the same deadline as the application materials.
